U.S. Highway 220, Closure of Northbound Access Ramp to Blue Ridge Parkway Planned from July 12 to 16.

(Roanoke, VA)

Closure of the Blue Ridge Parkway's northbound access ramp at U.S. Route 220, milepost 121.4, in Roanoke, Virginia, is planned for July 12 until July 16, 2010. This ramp closure is required to repair approximately 150 linear feet of damaged curbing at the intersection of the ramp with US Route 220.

Detour traffic signage will direct motorists to the open southbound traffic ramp. Directional signs informing the public which ramp will be closed shall also be placed on Highway 220 and on the Parkway.

Ramp closure will take place during the construction period starting at 9:00 AM on Monday, July 12th, and ending at noon on Friday, July 16th, after which the ramp will be reopened for normal traffic.

Blue Ridge Parkway management regrets the inconvenience or delays this closure may cause Parkway visitors.
