Parkway Roanoke River Bridge Railing Repainting

(Roanoke, VA) On Wednesday, October 14, 2009, Enola Contracting Services, Inc. will begin repainting the metal railing on the Roanoke River Bridge, located at Milepost 114.66 just south of Virginia Route 24 at Vinton. After removal of the old paint and surface preparation, the railing along the 1,028 foot structure will undergo a three-part coating process. Contract crews will work day and night shifts to reduce inconvenience to park visitors, and one lane of traffic will remain open.

The project contract is expected to be completed January 2010.
